

themselves can convene the meeting as per the procedure stipulated for convening Annual General Meeting and any decision taken/resolutions passed thereof shall be considered and implemented by the Committee as if passed in the meeting duly convened. The Committee shall reimburse to the requisitionists the expenditure incurred for such meeting with requisite quorum.

35. For General Meetings, every participant member shall register his name in the form prescribed by the Committee so as to have the list of members attended the meeting.

36. **Notices.**- (i) Both the Annual General Meeting and the Extraordinary General Meeting shall be called with 21 days notice in writing at the least, excluding the day on which the notice is served or deemed to be served and the day of the meeting. The notice shall specify the place, the day and the hour of the meeting and in case of extraordinary General Meeting, the general nature for which the meeting called shall be given to all the members.

(ii) A notice shall be given by the Association or Committee to any member either personally or by sending the same through post addressed to such member to his address lastly registered in the Association.

(iii) All notices, if given by post, shall be deemed to have been served 48 hours after the envelope or wrapper containing the same was posted, and in proving such service it shall be sufficient that the envelope or wrapper containing the notice was properly addressed and put in the post. A certificate in writing, signed by the General Secretary, or other proper officer of the Association, that the envelope or wrapper containing the notice was so addressed and posted shall be conclusive evidence thereof.

(iv) The accidental omission to give notice of a meeting to, or the non-receipt of meeting by any person entitled to receive the same, shall not invalidate the proceedings at the meeting.

(v) Notice of every Annual General Meeting shall be given in any manner herein before authorized to every member whose registered address is within Tamilnadu and to the Auditor of the Association for the time being and to the Registrar, No other person shall be entitled to receive the notice of General Meeting.

37. **Proceedings At General Meetings.**- (i) All business to be transacted in General Body shall be by passing of resolution by majority votes of the members present, in favour of.

(ii) The quorum for both Annual General Meeting or Special or Extra- Ordinary General Meetings shall be 10 percent of the total strength of the Association. *or, 50 Members which ever is less.*

(iii) If within half an hour after the time appointed for the Meeting, a quorum is not present, the Meeting, if convened upon the requisition of the members shall be dissolved, and in any other case the Chairman, may, if he thinks fit, permit the reading and discussion of any paper but not any other business, as subjects thereto, and shall either declare the meeting dissolved or adjourn it to such time and place as he may determine, and if at the adjourned meeting a quorum is not present within half an hour after the time appointed for the Meeting, the members present shall be the quorum.
