- (iii) The proposed Amendments shall be discussed in the Annual General Meeting or Special or Extraordinary meeting and may be amended in any manner pertinent to the subject matter.
- (iv) Any matter silent in these Articles, may be filled in by the Committee by a two-third majority of the total strength of the Committee consistent with Societies Registration Act 1975.
- 43. OFFICIAL PUBLICATIONS. (i) The Association shall publish a periodical, Daily or Weekly or fortnightly or monthly as may be determined by the Committee, namely, இந்தியன் (Indian) / "நேர்மை (NAERMAI)". Notices and announcements published in the periodical related to the affairs of the Association shall be deemed to have been served to the member. The periodical may be sold to the public for a price as may be determined by the Committee.
- (ii) The officers responsible and in charge for the publication of periodicals shall be nominated by the Committee.
- (iii) Any matter, if acceptable in the opinion of the Committee, to achieve the objectives of the Association, can be published.
- (iv) The periodical, if necessary shall be registered with the authorities concerned.

APPENDIX 1 – ELECTION RULES [See Article 21]

- 1. Short title.- These rules may be called the Election Rules for the election of office bearers of the Association.
- 2. Eligibility of a candidate.- A candidate seeking election to any office of the Committee shall be a member of the Association on the date of calling for nomination and should have paid the current annual subscription.
- 3. Filing of Nominations.- (i) The nomination of a candidate shall be filed prior to the date and time stipulated in the election schedule in the prescribed format annexed to these rules.
 - ii) A nomination filed by a candidate, on scrutiny, if found to be violative of these election rules or Bye-Laws or articles of the Association, will be declared invalid.
 - iii) A candidate shall be proposed by a member and seconded by another member.
