- 9. Authority competent to sue or be sued.- The officer authorised to sue or be sued on behalf of the Association shall normally be the General Secretary of the Association. The Committee can also authorise any member of the Association in this behalf.
- 10. Authority to issue directions.- The officer competent to issue directions on behalf of the Association shall be the General Secretary.
- 11. Patrons .- Prominent citizens who are committed to the aims and objectives of the Association can be chosen as patrons of the Association. Patrons for the Branch units can be nominated with the concurrence of the State unit.

ADMISSION OF MEMBERS

12.QUALIFICATION

- 1) Regular members
- (i) Any citizen of India above the age of 18 years living in India or abroad irrespective of sex, caste, religion, race or profession whether independent / private / government shall be qualified to become a member of the Association.

Any foreign national, above the age of 18 committed to the principles of the Anticorruption Movement living in India can be considered for admission on individual basis.

- (ii) He shall be selfless and service minded and determined to work towards the set goals
- 2) Student Members

Bonafide students of Educational Institutions subject to the minimum age of 18, shall be admitted as student members. In the case of students below 18 years of age the application should be countersigned by the Parent / Guardian. Student members are eligible for waiver of subscription and admission fees. Student members shall participate in the activities of the Movement in eradicating corruption and they shall NOT have voting rights and not be entrusted with any organizational position or responsibility. A student member shall cease to be such on ceasing to be a student. The student members are eligible to receive identity cards and other publications on payment of the charges fixed by the Committee. The identity card should be surrendered on ceasement of membership.

3) Volunteers

In order to provide an opportunity for the general public committed to fighting corruption a cadre of volunteers known as 'Anti-corruption Volunteers' may be formed by enrolling interested persons at a nominal subscription of Rs.20/- per annum. They will be issued identity cards with the nomenclature of 'Volunteer'. They will not have the rights of regular members nor can they hold any office in the Movement or participate in the business meetings of the General Body or Committee at any level.
