

23. Proceedings. - (i) The Committee shall normally meet once in a month. Notice of an Executive Committee Meeting shall normally be given at least 7 days before the date of the meeting. The Agenda for the meeting shall be indicated in the notice of information. If any member is desirous of bringing in a subject for discussion, he shall inform in writing to the President at least 3 days before the date of the meeting for his approval.

(ii) The quorum for the Executive Committee Meeting shall be 5(five). If the required quorum is not available the meeting shall be postponed to a date not earlier than 7 days after the adjourned meeting, and notice issued with at least 3 days before the meeting. No quorum is necessary for such a reconvened meeting.

(iii) The decision of the Committee shall be by passing of resolutions by a simple majority. In case of equality of votes, the Chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote. The Proceedings of the Committee shall be recorded in the Minutes Book by the General Secretary and shall be approved by the chairman.

(iv) The President or any five Members of the Committee may at any time direct the General Secretary to convene the meeting of the Committee and the General Secretary shall convene such meeting as directed. The said five members, if the General Secretary fails to call for such meeting, can convene the meeting.

(v) The President, or in his absence the Vice President, shall preside over the meetings of the Committee. In the absence of both, the members of the Committee shall choose one among them as Chairman of the meeting.

(vi) The decision of the Committee on any subject matter shall be by show of hands. The resolutions recorded in the Minutes Book that it is passed or lost by a particular majority votes and duly signed by the Chairman shall be the conclusive proof of the transaction and correctness of the resolutions passed in the meeting.

(vii) All acts done by any meeting of the Committee or of a Sub-Committee or by any person acting as a member of the Committee shall, notwithstanding it be afterwards discovered that there was some defect in the appointment of any member or person acting as aforesaid or that they or any of them were disqualified or had vacated office, be valid as if every said person had been duly appointed and had continued to be a member of the Committee.

(viii) In cases of Emergency, any resolution can be got passed by circulation among the members of the Committee, which shall be valid and effectual as if transacted in a duly convened meeting.

24. Powers and Duties.- Without prejudice to these Articles or Statutes the Committee shall have the following powers:

(i) To invest the money of the Association not immediately required in such securities or otherwise in such manner as may from time to time be determined.

(ii) To dispose of the undertaking or property of the Association or any part thereof for such consideration as the Committee may think fit.

(iii) To get the Association registered or recognized.

(iv) To approve the expenditure of the Funds of the Association.
